- St Gabriel's Babies' Home, Balwyn (1935 - 1974) Service moved from Arms of Jesus Babies home, adoptions and mothercraft training
- St Luke's Toddlers Home, Bendigo (1932 - 1979) (AKA Langley Hall)
- Seaside Garden, Phillip Island (c. 1934 - 35) adjacent property to St Paul's
- The Manor, Morwell (1979 -) Crisis accommodation for families
- Thuruna, Traralgon (1976 - ?) Family group home
